Purpose

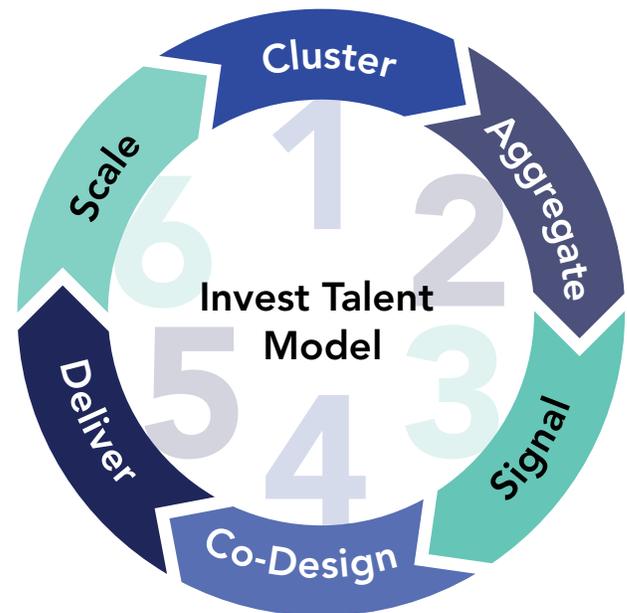
The Invest Talent Playbook outlines Invest Vancouver's employer-led, data-driven approach to workforce development in globally competitive sectors. It is designed to help employers access job-ready talent while enabling funders to invest in scalable, evidence-based workforce systems.

Why Invest Talent

Export-oriented firms drive regional prosperity but increasingly cite workforce availability, job readiness, and hiring friction as constraints on growth and investment. Traditional training systems often lag behind real-world demand. Invest Talent addresses this gap by placing employers at the centre of talent system design.

What Employers Can Expect

- Reduced hiring friction through shared demand signals
- Training aligned to real jobs - not generic credentials
- Faster access to job-ready, locally available talent

The Invest Talent Model

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Step 1: Priority Sector & Role Identification

As a neutral convener, Invest Vancouver utilizes labour market and economic data to identify and cluster export-oriented sectors to create regional prosperity and long-term demand growth.

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Step 2: Employer Demand Aggregation

As employers align, they validate labour market data, confirm priority roles, and assess readiness to participate in collective solutions.

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Step 3: Skills Needs Forum

Translate employer demand into clear, shared signals for post-secondary, workforce, and community partners.

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Step 4: Co-Design

Employers and training and community partners collaboratively design short-cycle, applied interventions aligned to real job requirements.

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Step 5: Delivery & Support

Implement training or ecosystem interventions, supported by workforce intermediaries and community organizations.

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Step 6: Measure, Learn & Scale

Evaluate outcomes, capture system-level learning, and refine the model for replication.

Invest Talent provides a shared framework for employers, training providers, and community organizations to work together intentionally, inclusively, and at scale.

This creates a dynamic model that allows workforce systems to evolve alongside industry needs and informs how policy, practice, and investment can be aligned to support long-term regional growth.
